Transferring from the paediatric to the adult Audiology service

Your review appointment

At your review appointment we will start thinking about transferring your Audiology care from the children's to the adult service. Everyone transfers at different times, and at this appointment we will talk about when will be the best time for you.

Like any other review, we will also:

1. Check your hearing levels.
2. Review your hearing aids (and change them or update them if necessary).
3. Refer you for additional advice and/or support at your request.

It is important that you attend the appointment so that we can provide you with information about the adult service, as there are some important differences. You will see the **Transfer Audiologist**, who you can contact at any time if you have any questions, or problems keeping appointments.
