Construction Update

There has been considerable activity on site this month, including...

Lots of excavations!

Excavations for the foundations have been taking place in the main site area; excavations for the basement link corridor have been happening in the area between the Rosie and the K wards; and excavations for the main basement have been taking place adjacent to the Addenbrooke's Treatment Centre (ATC), plus excavations for the bases of the tower cranes which will soon be coming to site.

Installation of a Perspex stud frame to Rosie windows on level 1 outpatients clinic (facing K wards) – to protect the windows from the construction activities.

The demolition of the Rosie entrance canopy

This will be a very noisy and disruptive procedure as the canopy is made from 25 tonnes of concrete! Further information will be made available regarding this work to those directly affected.

The traffic lights on Robinson Way have moved up the road to facilitate the connection of the foul sewage drain into the main sewer.

The footpath on Robinson Way is closed

Please avoid this area if possible and use the entrance at the 'N' wards or the ATC to access the Rosie, Breast Unit and Child Development Centre.
